FAST FACTS

PCOM South Georgia, an additional teaching location of Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine (PCOM), offers the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree and the Master of Science in Biomedical Sciences degree.

Situated on 31 acres in Moultrie, Georgia, a city of about 14,000 people in Southwest Georgia, the campus features a 75,000-square-foot facility completed in August 2019. The building includes expansive classrooms, study spaces, modern osteopathic manipulative medicine and anatomy labs, a Simulation Center, numerous exam and practice rooms, a dining area, information commons and a large outside courtyard for gathering and studying.

FOCUS

PCOM South Georgia enrolled its first class in 2019 in response to the acute need for more healthcare providers to serve the growing population of Georgia and the surrounding states. The College encourages graduates to serve in rural areas with severe physician shortages.
